



Bad Boy Golf Group Basic Rules

- (1) A "Give Me" put must be within the handle grip of the putter.
- (2) If your ball has mud on it, you may "lift, clean, and place". This rule applies any time of the year.
- (3) A hit ball may be replaced by another ball at any time.
- (4) We have the "root rule", but good judgement should be used. The ball being moved should not be moved more than one club length.
- (5) Bunkers with water. If your ball lands in bunker water, then you must move the ball to a non-water location in the bunker. If the entire bunker is filled with water, then you must drop the ball "behind" the bunker without a penalty stroke.
- (6) If your ball comes to rest on the bank or the edge of a water hazard but is "not" in the water or mud, you may move the ball one club length no closer to the hole. This rule is to prevent a player from falling into the water but should not be abused.
- (7) If the golf course we are playing has a "temporary green", take a maximum of "two putting strokes". Your ball must be on the green to count as a "putting stroke".
- (8) If you hit your ball into the side of a sand bunker and it is "buried" (looks like a fried egg), you may lift it out and then place it back on that spot without a penalty stroke.
- (9) If you hit a bowl into a "high grass rough" and can not find your bowl. You may place a ball in the location that the ball was thought to have landed without a penalty stroke but, **it "must" be validated by another player in your group.**
